The Durham Masonic Caravan and Camping Club is dedicated to safeguarding and preserving your privacy when visiting our site or communicating electronically with us. Our Privacy Policy has been provided and approved by [internet law](#) specialists LegalCentre.co.uk.

This Privacy Policy, together with our terms of use, explains what happens to any personal data that you provide to us, or that we collect from you when you are on this site.

We do update this Policy from time to time so please do return and review this Policy regularly.

For the purpose of the Data Protection Act 1998 our data controller is the Secretary, George Slater.

Information We Collect

In operating our website we may collect and process the following data about you:

- i. Details of your visits to our website and the resources that you access, including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, weblogs and other communication data.
- ii. Information that you provide by filling in forms on our website, such as when you registered for information or order merchandise.
- iii. Information provided to us when you communicate with us for any reason.

Use of Cookies

We may on occasion gather information regarding your computer whilst you are on our website. This enables us to improve our services and to provide statistical information regarding the use of our website.

Such information will not identify you personally it is statistical data about our visitors and their use of our site. This statistical data does not identify any personal details whatsoever.

All computers have the ability to decline cookies. This can be done by activating the setting on your browser which enables you to decline the cookies. Please note that should you choose to decline cookies, you may be unable to access particular parts of our website.

Other sites, to which we provide links, may also use cookies, over which we have no control. Such cookies (if used) would be downloaded once you click on the link on our website.

Use of Your Information

The information that we collect and store relating to you is primarily used to enable us to provide better services to you. In addition, we may use the information for the following purposes:

- i. To provide you with information requested from us, relating to rallies or merchandise or social events. To provide other related information which we feel may be of interest to you.
- ii. To meet any contractual commitments we may have to you.
- iii. To notify you about any changes to our website, such as improvements or rally/merchandise changes.

Storing Your Personal Data

Data that is provided to us is securely stored on our server.

The transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure and therefore we cannot guarantee the security of data sent to us electronically and transmission of such data is therefore entirely at your own risk. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password so that you can access certain parts of our site, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential.

Disclosing Your Information

We will only disclose your personal information to other members of the Club when you have given your permission so to do.

We may also disclose your personal information to third parties but only where we are legally required to disclose your information

Access To Information

The Data Protection Act 1998 gives you the right to access the information that we hold about you.
